

Share What will the adult(s) do when the information about what the desired child does the desired behavior? behavior looks and sounds like, noting multiple acceptable options children can choose from. **Setting Details** Antecedent Where, When, with What happens right before the Who? undesired behavior? **Undesired Behavior** Consequence Describe the behavior; use objective Consequences must be language sharing only what you can immediate, relevant, and in observe (see/hear). proportion to the behavior. Consequences must always align with the program's Behavior _ Guidance Policy. Function **Replacement Behavior** What is the child either getting or What option(s) does the child have for avoiding by engaging in the alternatives to the undesired behavior? undesired behavior? This is a clue to identify replacement behaviors; what are acceptable ways for them to get their needs met?
