Proactive Intervention Program

Proactive Intervention Program of Anoka County is a community collaborative program that addresses the needs of young children who present challenging behaviors in their early childhood setting. We provide intervention and support for children birth through age 5 yrs. and their families, and technical support and training for early childhood care providers and educators.

One of the parenting components of our program is called "Parents Time Out" which is a support and education group. It includes the entire family and begins with dinner, followed by a facilitated Parents Group and qualified child care for the children. There is no cost to families for this group.
